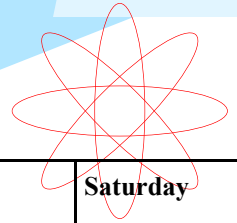


# PERFORMING ARTS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

Jazz/Hip-Hop— is based on elements of ballet and modern dance with syncopation and isolation of the body. It is fused with high energy urban movement inspired by today's Hip-Hop music videos.	Ballet— Focuses on proper body alignment, flexibility, strength, turnout & extension. Ballet is the foundation for all styles of dance.	Modern— is a dance form that integrates ballet, jazz, and ethnic dance technique. Classes focus on movement that expresses music, emotion, and spacial awareness	Salsa for kids—This class focuses on rhythm and fluidity of hips and total body. The basic Salsa steps are taught along with some styling and turns.	Ballroom Basics — The 4 basic elements of Ballroom Dancing are taught and an interrelated system is used to introduce students to Ballroom Dancing.	Acting— Beginners covers from the basics of stage directions & lingo to non-verbal acting, acting games, skits & monologues. Intermediate reviews scripts and characters and Advanced includes video feedback, working with teleprompters, green screen, and characterization.	Drama—includes dramatic and serious acting, emotion evoking dialogue, challenging roles, and skits from dramatic plays and movies. It is a unique, fun, imaginative, and suspenseful drama curriculum designed to help each child achieve <b>invaluable life skills.</b>	Private Lessons available in Guitar, Piano, Voice or Drums. Emphasis is placed on fundamentals, technique and proper hand placement or breathing as applicable.
